



**Samia Hurst** is a physician bioethicist, ethics consultant, and professor of Bioethics at Geneva University's medical school in Switzerland, where she chairs the Institute for Ethics, History and the Department of Community Health and Medicine. She has conducted studies on bedside rationing and citizen preferences regarding resource allocation, she is the author of the definition of vulnerability integrated into the Declaration of Helsinki and the CIOMS international ethical guidelines on health-related research involving humans, and is one of the organizers of the Resisting Borders conference, the first entirely border-free international conference on the rights of migrants and refugees. She is a member of the Senate at the Swiss Academy of Medical Sciences and of the Swiss National Advisory Commission on Biomedical Ethics. Her research focuses on fairness in clinical practice and the protection of vulnerable persons.
