



Prof. Mauricio Avendano

Associate Professor, Department of Epidemiology and Health Systems, Unisanté – University of Lausanne

Mauricio Avendano is a social epidemiologist and Associate Professor at the University of Lausanne, where he co-directs the Health Economics & Policy Unit at Unisanté. His research examines how public policies and social change shape health and health inequalities across populations.

He holds honorary appointments as Adjunct Associate Professor at the Harvard T.H. Chan School of Public Health and Visiting Professor at King's College London. In 2024, he was elected International Fellow of the British Academy.

Prof. Avendano leads and collaborates on numerous international research projects focused on child and adolescent mental health, health systems, and social determinants of health. His work is supported by institutions such as the US National Institutes of Health (NIH), the Swiss National Science Foundation (SNSF), and the UK Wellcome Trust. Recent studies include large-scale interventions in Brazil and Colombia and evaluations of mental health inequalities in Switzerland.
