



Prof. Nicole Probst-Hensch

Professor of Public Health, University Basel; Head, Department of Epidemiology and Public Health, Swiss TPH

Nicole Probst-Hensch is a public health expert and epidemiologist with a dual background in pharmacy and epidemiology. She is Head of the Department of Epidemiology and Public Health at Swiss TPH and Full Professor at the University of Basel. Her interdisciplinary research bridges chronic disease epidemiology, environmental health, exposome science, and personalized medicine.

She has led or co-led numerous national and international cohort studies and biobanking initiatives, including the long-standing SAPALDIA cohort and the COVCO study. Her work focuses on the causal effects of environmental exposures and health inequalities, with applications in Switzerland, Europe, and low- and middle-income countries.

Prof. Probst-Hensch also serves as Academic Co-Director of the Swiss School of Public Health (SSPH+) and holds advisory roles in several national and international scientific boards.
