Claudio Peter, PhD, MSc, is a psychologist and epidemiologist with extensive expertise in mental health surveillance and psychological adaptation. He serves as Head of the Mental Health Unit at the Swiss Health Observatory (Obsan), a joint institution of the Swiss Confederation and the cantons. He holds a doctorate in human biology from the Ludwig Maximilian University of Munich and a Master of Science in Epidemiology from the London School of Hygiene & Tropical Medicine.

His academic work focuses on mental health, rehabilitation psychology, and the epidemiology of spinal cord injury. He has contributed significantly to both national public health monitoring and the scientific literature, publishing extensively in peer-reviewed journals and co-authoring Obsan reports on mental health in Switzerland.

Dr. Peter is a member of the Swiss Society for Psychiatric Epidemiology and has served on various expert groups, including within the Swiss Spinal Cord Injury Cohort Study (SwiSCI).
