Michael Musalek is Professor of Psychiatry at the Sigmund Freud University in Vienna, where he also serves as Chair of the Department of General Psychiatry and leads the Institute for Social Aesthetics and Mental Health in both Vienna and Berlin. He is a trained psychiatrist, neurologist, and psychotherapist, with a long-standing commitment to integrating medicine, aesthetics, and mental health.

He has held numerous leadership positions, including General Medical Director of the Anton Proksch Institute and President of the European Society for Aesthetics and Medicine. His research spans social aesthetics, the phenomenology of mental disorders, clinical diagnostics, and medical humanities. He has published over 300 scientific articles and serves on the editorial boards of various academic journals. In recognition of his work, he has received high national honours from both the Republic of Austria and the Province of Vienna.
