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Professor Olivia Keiser is an Assistant Professor of Epidemiology at the Institute of Global Health, University of Geneva and the Director of the GRAPH Network. Prof. Keiser is also the Head of the Infectious Diseases and Mathematical Modelling Division where her group takes an interdisciplinary research approach by combining mathematical modelling (including cost-effectiveness analyses), analyses of cohort data, data- and text mining, systematic reviews, and qualitative research techniques. Predominant areas of focus include HIV, tuberculosis, and COVID-19. The group has been expanding their work to other infectious diseases and investigating the interaction between communicable and non-communicable diseases. International collaboration are at the center of the group's activities with the overall goal of building capacity in low and middle income countries.
