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Christoph Rehmann-Sutter is a Swiss philosopher and bioethicist. Born 1959 in Laufenburg, he studied molecular biology at the Biozentrum in Basel, specializing in nuclear magnetic resonance NMR. Then he switched to bioethics, studied philosophy and sociology. Since 1990 he had funded research projects on the ethics of risks, gene therapy, embryonic stem cell research and end-of-life decisions, while establishing a research unit of bioethics at the university of Basel. 2001-2008 he was elected President of the Swiss National Advisory Commission on Biomedical Ethics. Until 2026 he was Professor of Theory and Ethics in the Biosciences at the University of Lübeck, Germany, now he is Co-Speaker of the Collaborative Research Centre 1665 "Sexdiversity", funded by the German Science Foundation DFG.
